





PAMA is growing fast




Revenues per cause

Board members contributions




Financial Efficiency Performance Metrics

Fundraising Expense Percentage:

\$ to Fundraising /\$ to total expense. Goal < 10%



Fundraising Efficiency:

- \$ to fundraising/\$ totally revenues
- charity navigator target is < 10%
 - each dollar should generate \$10
 - In PAMA's case each dollar generated \$25

Fundraising expense	\$32,589
Total revenues	\$785,341
Fundraising efficiency. Goal is < 10%	4.15%

Financial Capacity Performance Metrics

- Working Capital Ratio: Determines how long (in years) a charity could sustain its level of spending using only its net available assets.
 - Goal is 3 years
 - PAMA is building its net asset. So far, we can sustain our operations for 1 year, assuming we will be spending \$500,000 a year.
- <u>Liabilities to Assets Ratio</u>: total liabilities compared to total assets, goal < 5%
 - PAMA has no liabilities
